FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Are lifejackets required?

Lifejackets are not required, but are available on a first come first serve basis. Lifejackets are located beside the lazy river.

How can I tell my schools students from other schools?

Each school that visits on the same day will have different color wristbands. Example: X School with have Blue Wristbands and Y School with have Red Wristbands.

Will parents be allowed?

That is up to your school! If you allow parents, their tickets will need to be pre-purchased through your school. Parrot Island has no way of knowing your parents from the general public. For example: X School will need a headcount for how many parents are attending and pre-purchase X amount of parent tickets. We will allow schools to sell parent tickets the day of at a table outside the front gate.

Can the students exit without me knowing?

Due to fire regulations we cannot shut and lock the front gate. We will however have a chaperone table set up at the front gate on the day of your visit. We recommend having one school representative stationed there, but it is not required.



Can we bring our own lunch?

Yes. Sack lunches can be brought in for students.

Are your food stands open?

Yes. The Island Breeze Snack Shack and Mini Melts Ice Cream will be open.

Can my school use a cabana for the day?

Yes. Only on School Dayz cabanas are free to use. Most schools use them as a meeting place, and a place for teachers, and school staff to stay cool and still be in the park with their students.

How do we get our tickets?

The group sales department will get you an allocated amount of wristbands before your event. On the day of your visit just bring back what you have leftover. You will only be charged for what you did not bring back.
